COVID UPDATE 7/11/2022

Friends Home (Personal Care) side

Unfortunately, we had another positive case in the Friends Home staff on Sunday. We are maintaining the **YELLOW** status in Friends Home but with additional restrictions.

All visits must occur outside until this outbreak is resolved. Residents will be on the porch and family must stay in the yard. Please call the Health Center at extension 209 to set up the visit. Staff will escort the resident to the porch, and we will ensure seating is present on the lawn.

Residents can go out for medical appointments. We will test the resident the morning of their appointment. Please call the medical provider prior to the date of the appointment to ensure they want to see our resident with our **YELLOW** status. The provider may request to reschedule.

Due to the high community transmission, we are asking all residents to not leave Friends Home for social reasons. This will only be in effect until our outbreak is resolved.

Residents are able to leave their rooms with masks on but **MUST** continue to not have any contact with other residents. Staff will be assisting those residents who need reminders.

We are allowing for continued therapy services for our **YELLOW** residents. Some of the COVID positive residents have been followed by therapy as determined necessary by medical personnel.

Friends Home residents will be retested Tuesday, July 12. Once all this information is obtained another update will be provided.

Linden Hall

All residents and the majority of the staff have been tested and there have not been any new cases. Linden Hall is now **YELLOW** with the exception of visitation.

Due to the high community transmission, we are asking for all Linden Hall visits be held outside until we return to **GREEN**. Please call the nursing station at 206 to set up a time. If an outdoor visit is not possible, please call Josephine to discuss other safe options.

Residents can go out for medical appointments. We will test the resident the morning of their appointment. Please call the medical provider prior to the date of the appointment to ensure they want to see our resident with our **YELLOW** status. The provider may request to reschedule.

Residents are able to leave their rooms with masks on but **MUST** continue to not have any contact with other residents. Staff will be assisting those residents who need reminders.

We are allowing for continued therapy services for our **YELLOW** residents.

Linden Hall residents and staff will be retested Tuesday, July 12 and an update will follow once results are obtained.
