COVID UPDATE 7/12/2022

Effective Wednesday July 13th both Linden Hall and Friends Home will return to **Green** status. This means all residents who are not still on isolation will be able to participate in Community Life activities and eat in the dining room.

Visitation can resume but due to the high community transmission of this new variant we are asking all visitors to be very cautious. Visitors must wear a mask at all times, take the COVID screen and please do not visit if you have had any possible exposure to COVID outside of Friends Home.

Those residents still on isolation **RED** will be able to have their restrictions lifted once they test negative or have reached day 10 and do not have significant symptoms. The nursing staff are aware of these dates and will inform residents and their families on when each person is off isolation.

At this time, we do not have any residents who are quarantined, **YELLOW**. For clarification, quarantine is for those residents with a significant exposure to a person with known COVID.

I am afraid this will not be the last time we need to manage COVID, but we will continue to manage this virus in the safest, least restrictive manner possible.
